

**Criteria for Determining Quarantine Requirements Based on Travel Outside Colorado**

**9/12/2020**

1. Did the student or staff member themselves travel outside of Colorado?
  - a. If NO, there is no need to quarantine
  - b. If YES, go to question 2
  
2. Did the student or staff member follow the Five Commitments and Safety Protocols?
  - a. If NO, the student or staff member will need to quarantine for 14 days
  - b. If YES, go to question 3
  
3. Did the student or staff member travel to or through any hotspot counties (including airports)?
  - a. If NO, go to question 4
  - b. If YES, the student or staff member may be required to quarantine for up to 14 days, after the Superintendent reviews the metrics for the counties traveled to and through; continue on to question 4
  
4. Did the student or staff member travel by plane?
  - a. If NO, the student or staff member will NOT need to quarantine, unless determined by the Superintendent related to question 3b
  - b. If YES, the student or staff member will need to quarantine for 14 days after their return flight, unless they have two negative COVID tests 3 days apart after returning, in which case the quarantine period can be reduced to 7 days.
